

2020 COVID Safety Protocols- Mogollon Jr./Sr. High School

Before School

- ★ Each student will have their temperature taken at the beginning of each school day, students with a temperature of 100.4 or higher will be required to return to their house and engage in learning through their virtual account.
- ★ Upon arrival students should remain outside, report to their homeroom class, or report to the cafeteria if they are getting breakfast.
- ★ It is recommended that students wear face coverings throughout the day, especially when social distancing isn't possible.
- ★ Parents should avoid going to the office, especially when a phone call would suffice.

During Class

- ★ Desks should be arranged in the classrooms to allow maximum distance between students.
- ★ Students should work independently at their desks throughout each class period. Group work should be avoided.
- ★ Teachers should recommend that students wear masks during class.
- ★ If a student is not feeling well, he should be sent to the office to be checked by the nurse or office personnel, please call the office to notify a secretary.
- ★ The last 2 minutes of class should be used to sanitize desktops, computers, etc.

Between Class Periods

- ★ Teachers should remind their students to wear their masks when in the hallways between classes.
- ★ Students should report immediately to their next class unless they need to use the restroom.
- ★ Congregating in groups in the hallway should be avoided.
- ★ Students should avoid using their lockers between classes. If possible they should use a backpack to carry their books from one class to another to avoid unnecessary use of their locker.
- ★ Students should be instructed to wash their hands properly and consistently.

Lunch

- ★ Students should maintain social distancing in the cafeteria by spreading out among the tables.
- ★ Students should maintain a 6' distance from each other while in the lunch line and while sitting at the tables.
- ★ Congregating in large groups in the cafeteria, in the halls, or outside should be avoided.
- ★ Students should wear their face covering when they are not eating and after they leave the cafeteria.
- ★ 7th and 8th graders will have staggered lunch times. 7th graders will be in the cafeteria from 11:55-12:10 and the 8th graders will be outside for lunch recess. 8th graders will then go to the cafeteria between 12:10-12:30

After School

- ★ Students should leave campus as soon as possible. Loitering after school should be avoided.
- ★ Students involved in afterschool activities should report immediately to their activity.
- ★ Gathering in groups should be avoided.
- ★ Students riding the bus should sit away from other students that are not siblings. Sitting in every other row should be the proper practice.

Protocols for all times of the day

- ★ Avoid gathering in groups.
- ★ It is recommended that students wear a face covering.
- ★ Wash hands properly (>20 seconds) and frequently.
- ★ Maintain social distancing (at least 6 feet apart).
- ★ Avoid touching others.
- ★ Regardless of personal opinions, be respectful of other individuals' precautions, personal sanitary preferences, and practices. No one should be ridiculed or made fun of for wearing or not wearing a mask.
